Meeting with CMD, CCL:

03.05.18: A joint meeting of JSIA & FJCCI was held with Mr. Gopal Singh, CMD, CCL., initiated by Sri Mahesh Poddar, Member, RS, was held at 5:00 P.M. at CCL HQ. amidst presence of other senior officers from CCL. President & Mr. H.P. Biyani from JSIA & Sri Kunal Ajmani, Sri Deepak Kr. Maroo and Sri Mahesh Tikmani & three other coal trades were present from FJCCI.

JSIA raised the matter of TCS, recovered from Permanent Linkage consumers by CCL on behest of IT department and it was requested to issue a letter from CCL mentioning the amount recovered/ adjusted, which would be refunded to consumers, if CCL gets verdict in their favour against the petition filed by them with the Commissioner IT.

On matter of inordinate delay in issue of Coal Delivery orders after depositing the cost of coal, CMD directed the sales people to get the verification all documents required, before accepting the coal amount from the consumers so that DO can be released within couple of days.

It was also decided to ensure that D.O would be issued only from collieries which are operative. Priority would be given to MSE consumers in allotment at colliery level on mutual agreement between MSE consumers & coal traders.

On our request, CMD directed to hold meeting of JSIA & FJCCI with Director Finance every two months to resolve issues & its regular follow up.

Meeting on Textile Policy:

05.05.18:

In view of certain discrepancies and dissimilarities in various clauses of **Jharkhand Textile, Apparel and Footwear Policy 2016** a stakeholder consultation meeting was organized at 11.30 AM, at Irrigation Conference Hall, First Floor, Nepal House, Doranda, Ranchi, under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Department of Industries, Mines and Geology along with Director Industries, K Ravi Kumar.

Shri Adarash Ramsisaria and Shri Kanishka Poddar represented JSIA in the said meeting. The amendment suggested by the department was related to setting up a textile park in the state. The amendment was to liberalizes the process of Capital Investment Subsidy disbursement, its slabs and rules.

JSIA suggested following additional amendments, which were acknowledged by Director Industries:

- a) Subsidy application process should be simplified for Micro & Small Industries in terms of documents required.
- b) Clarity was requested on whether 50% subsidy available on cost of land would also be available in scenario where government is giving land/sheds/buildings on rent to industries. It was also pointed out that rents fixed by the government is exuberantly high and needs to be revised.
- c) Possession of lands allotted to industries is not being given on time and local problems need to be solved by the department.

Meeting with GM, JBVNL, Ranchi area:

08.05.18: A delegation of JSIA comprising President, VP, Hon. Secretary, Sri Binod Tulsian & Sri Ravi Tibrewal attended a meeting with Sri Danesh Jha, GM cum Chief Engineer, JBVNL at his chamber amidst presence of SEE, concerned EEES & SDOs. at 3:00 P.M.

Various pending issues related to Power supply, delay in Billing, Frequent tripping, remission of 25% on Fixed charges, Dedicated Industrial feeders and non compliance of clauses under supply code were brought to his notice and was requested to resolve the same ASAP.

Sri Dhanesh Jha, expressing deep concern, took up each issue point wise and directed concerned EEES to resolve the same within time line as confirmed by them. He also emphasized that time has changed and officers of the Vitaran Nigam has to change their attitude and work for the benefit of the consumers. He assured our delegation that he would monitor at his level to resolve pending matters soon.

It was decided to meet our delegation every month for follow up and to minimize consumer's grievances.

Meeting with RBI:

18.05.18: Sri H.P.Biyani attended the meeting of MSME Empowered Committee at RBI, at 11.00 A.M amidst presence of Bankers & other committee members.

Friday Meetings:

04.05.18: Sri Siba Prasad Nayak, AGM, SIDBI, Ranchi visited JSIA at 5.30P.M. and had an interactive meeting with the members. He apprised about the SMILE scheme under which unit can get term loan @ 7.8% from SIDBI. He urged members to come forward & avail credit from SIDBI. He informed that DGM, from Lucknow also propose to meet members of JSIA during his Ranchi visit on 11th May'18.

Mr. P.K.Gupta, Director, MSME-DI along with Mr. A.K.Giri & Mr. Subhash Angewar both Asstt. Directors and gave detail Presentation for Exporting units on trade agreement, India has entered with Peru & Israel

and sought feedback from members on different rate of Import duty of items. As there was exhaustive list of items, it was felt to submit suggestions/feedback in due course. Mr. Gupta was also requested to arrange a workshop with FIEO for more clarifications on the EXIM policy and the products which units in Jharkhand can export.

11.05.18: Sri Arup Kumar, DGM, SIDBI, Lukhnow & Regional Head visited JSIA along with Sri Siba Prasad Nayak, AGM & Ms Sweta and had a very productive interaction with members present. As he had a long association with many of our members during his tenure at Ranchi, he was pleased to meet them. He remembered as how SIDBI branch started working in Ranchi and many units of JSIA availed credit from SIDBI. He talked about SMILE scheme and credit rating of units. He also answered specific queries from members and suggested remedy.
