Presentations were given by various speakers on issues related to Commercial Taxes, Electricity & Health services. President Arun Khemka also appraised the Minister of various anomalies in commercial tax department viz, non functioning of Advisory committee, non refund of amount of JAVAT input credit to Exporting units, disparity in rate of JVAT for few items & to reconsider recent Notification imposing heavy penalties, on delay in submission of Monthly Returns & payment of JVAT/CST. The Minister gave a patient hearing to all and assured to organize a meeting with the concerned department for resolving above issues.
- **(B)** President, PP & Hony Secretary also visited JSMDC and met Mr. Chandrma Mishra, GM and appraised him of inordinate delay in release of monthly Coal Delivery Orders as well as non issue of coal invoices for last many months. Mr Mishra called the dealing assistant and directed him to release the DOs within couple of days and invoices within a week.
- **(C)** JSIA delegation met with Mr. Sudhir Prasad, Addl Chief Secretary, D.W. & S.D, GOJ at his chamber at Nepal House at 3.00 P.M. The meeting was attended by

  - As a sample case reply of one Executive Engineer (Received by us through RTI) was placed and it was decided to obtain similar information from all other Executive Engineers to decide further action thereupon.
- b) Non compliance of BOQ conditions in case of Mini Rural Water Supply Scheme.
  - All Superintending Engineer has been directed to examine the matter & submit their report.
- Matter of non payments against supplies was discussed and Manufacturers were asked to submit necessary details.

#### 02.01.2014

President attended a meeting for discussion on 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission (FFC), at the Industries department, Nepal House, chaired by Ms Vandana Dadel, Secretary Industries. Ms Himany Pandey, Director Industries, Dy Director Industries & representatives from FJCCI & other Association from Santhal Pargana were also present in the meeting.

Secretary Industries explained that work of the FFC involves redressing the imbalance between taxation powers and expenditure responsibilities of the centre & the states respectively and equalization of all public services across the states. The secretary also handed over the Terms of reference of FFC to the representatives present, and requested them to submit their suggestions to the Industries department, before 6<sup>th</sup> instant so that it can be incorporated in the final presentation before the team of Finance committee, New Delhi, during their visit in Ranchi on 10.1.14.

#### 03.01.14

The IFC meeting scheduled on date was postponed for another date to be notified later.

#### 08.01.14

A seminar was organized on National Procurement Policy by CUTS International, Jaipur in association with JSIA, in Golden Jubilee Hall, Kokar. from 4.00P.M to 6.00P.M.

Ms Vinitha Jonson from CUTS International gave a power point presentation on the objectives of a National Procurement Policy in the country so as to address implementation concerns of the public procurement policies. To increase the level of awareness among the relevant stakeholders about the benefits which can be obtained through judicious use of public procurement. Now that the Draft Jharkhand Procurement policy-2013 has been conceptualized, by the Industries department, it becomes more relevant to sensitize the various stakeholders.

Mr Madhav Lakra, Director, MSME, also highlighted the MSMED Procurement Policy 2012, and said that by 2016, it will be mandatory for every PSU & Govt organization to procure 20% of their total procurement from MSMEs.

President Arun Khemka while welcoming the participants & other dignitaries, emphasized that the Procurement policy should be such as not to leave any escape route for PSUs.

Mr Bikash Singh, PP & President of FJCCI also expressed his concern over delay in notification of state Purchase Policy, which is overdue since 2012.

Ms Vandana Dadel, IAS, Secretary Industries, present as the Chief Guest in the meeting assured the house that the Draft Purchase policy of the state is ready and hopefully it will be notified within March'2014. She also asked JSIA to submit any other relevant suggestions on the policy, which can be incorporated in the later stage.

There was long deliberations from participants on various points related to Procurement Policy and Ms Vinitha Jonson answered the queries raised form members.

Mr Sharad poddar, VP conducted the meeting and Mr Y.K.Ojha, Hony Secretary proposed vote of thanks to everyone.

The meeting was closed followed by Hi Tea.

#### 10.01.14

A small delegation led by the President attended a meeting of the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission, (FFC) held at Hotel BNR, at 9.00A.M.

The Secretary Finance, Secretary Industries, Director Industries, Spl Secretary, Industries, and other officers were present at the meeting.

The FFC comprising the Chairman Mr Y.V.Reddy, former RBI Governor, along with his team gave a patient hearing to the presentations submitted by , Industries & trade viz, JSIA, FJCCI, Laghu Udyog Bharti & ASSOCHAM, during their allotted time of 15 minutes.

President, JSIA gave a power point presentation for Grant in Aid from central fund for development of new industrial area, development of Infrastructure, creation of Dry Port, improving facilities for exporting units etc. President also emphasized in his submission to simplify the structure of CST under proposed GST, which would be notified soon.

The representatives of FJCCI, Laghu Udyog Bharti & ASSOCHAM also submitted their points to the Commission for consideration as it would give boost to the growth of SMES in the state,

#### 14.01.14

A large delegation of 18 members led by President Sri Arun Khemka left for Gujarat on a 8 days industrial tour to Ahmedabad.

On 15 the delegation had Visited EDI Campus and post lunch they went to Udyog Bhawan at INDEXTb, which is the office of Commissioner Industries. They had a two hours meeting with DY. Commissioner Ind. Mr R.N.Raval, Dr C Chatterjee, Director, Center for Entrepreneur Dev. GOG, KPMG officers being knowledge partner for GIDC And INDEXTb. Mr J.Shah, GM, Adm. Was also present. Presentation of Vision Gujarat, Industrial policy was made and interaction took place. The level of transparency by making EM-I, II + Int. Subsidy its processing and disbursement all online was great. State subsidy on many front was in addition to Central subsidy Later on they visited Ceramic & Glass Research Institute

(CGCRI) to understand support of infrastructure to MSMEs. Mr Modi assured to help MSMEs of Jharkhand to exchange new Technologies in the industries and also develop more trade among the two states.

The team members of JSIA returned to Ranchi on 22<sup>nd</sup> Jan'14, enriched with experience & memories, they would cherish for long.

#### 17.01.14

Mr Y.K.Ojha, Hony Secretary attended a Board of Directors Meeting of Jharkhand Government Tool Room & Training Centre, (JGTRTC) under the chairmanship of Ms Himani Pandey, IAS, Secretary Industries. at her chamber at Nepal House at 3.00 P.M.

Agenda was discussed point wise and approval granted on various training & development program & proposed construction of trainees Hostel. Approval was also given on proposed annual Budget for 2014-15, of the Tool Room.

#### 23.01.14

President, Mr S.K.Agrawal,VP and Mr Randhir Sharma met Mr Shyama Prasad, Asst. Director, National Productivity Council from Bhuneshwar at Hotel Green Horizon, at 10.30 A.M.in connection with development of Clusters for consultancy in productivity & quality up gradation of MSMEs of Jharkhand . He agreed to provide all logistic support thru consultancy to small cluster comprising 6/7 units.

#### 27.01.14

A press conference was organized at JSIA Hall amid presence of delegates who had visited Gujarat, to narrate their experience and convey massage to the GoJ about good Governance there.

Mr Arun Khemka, President, Mr Ranjit Tibrewal, PP Mr Sharad Poddar VP & Mr C.K. Raipat apprised the press members about the visit of various Industrial areas at Vatwa, Naroda, Rajkot, Morbi & Wankaner and the growth of industries in MSME sector there. The units who have annual Turnover of more than 100 crore do not require NOC/CTO from Pollution department. Many industries are listed as non polluting one.

EM-Pt I & PT-II are online and are issued within 72 hours to all new entrepreneurs in Gujarat. It was also mentioned that albeit the I.P of Jharkhand is better in many respect than Gujarat, but implementation of provisions & matching notifications are lacking in Jharkhand, where as in Gujarat the department approaches the units to resolve the difficulties on policy matter. The raw materials for Glazed Tile and Sanitary ware manufacturing units are easily available in the state, where as in Jharkjhand the scenario is reverse for mineral based units. The role of Entrepreneur Development Institute( EDI) is very proactive to assist & develop new entrepreneurs.

Many members also shared their experience about positive approach of not only Bureaucrats but even Cabinet Ministers who are down to earth and spared their valuable time for JSIA delegates.

#### 28.01.14

A small delegation led by the President met Ms Himani Pandey, Secretary Industries, on a courtesy visit and congratulated her on appointment as Secretary Industries.

During the course of discussion her attention was drawn to pending EM-Pt II of many units, She assured to take action. Discussion was also held for principal approval from Industries department for development of Private Industrial Area, besides she was also requested to incorporate the provisions of Bihar Industrial Policy on development Private Industrial Area. She however, requested JSIA to provide her with the provisions of other states also for her study to pursue the matter. The issue of delay in grant of NOC & CTO from JSPCB were also discussed, and she was also requested to pursue the decision taken during joint meeting with CS, MS, Pollution Board & representative of JSIA & FJCCI, that Board would soon develop the system of filing all applications on line.

#### 30.01.14

One day Seminar/workshop was organized on behest of EDI, Ahmedabad at our Golden Jubilee hall from 10.30 A.M. to 4.00P.M.

President Mr Arun Khemka, in his welcome address said that during the recent visit at Gujarat, members of the delegation had an interaction with the officials of EDI at Ahmedabad, and were impressed by the development of new innovative products and how new entrepreneurs utilize the opportunity to set up their units.

Mr K.K.Shaw from EDI in his power point presentation apprised the members of new ideas & product & Business opportunities through Projects based on Science & Technology.

Few members also participated in one to one interaction session with Mr K.K.Shaw and gathered more information on the project they propose to set up in future.

#### 03.02.14

Mr Sharad Poddar, VP, attended Cluster development meeting on Refractory, Engineering & Food cluster. in the chamber of Secretary Industries, at Nepal House at 11.30 A.M

.It was decided to submit detailed Survey Report of proposed Engineering cluster before next meeting as such JSIA need to complete the formalities for the same.Peda cluster at Deoghar was rejected by Director, MSME,. Mr Sharad Poddar suggested that in the new financial year, a new proposal for Food Processing cluster should be taken up, to which every one agreed.

#### 07.02.14

- **A.** Mr Philip Mathew attended NOC Expert committee meeting with the MS, JSPCB at his chamber at 12.0'Clock. Following two cases came up for hearing:
  - 1) In the case of M/s Rajgunj Coke Product (P) Ltd., Dhanbad, NOC was denied as it has not been rejected by the committee , before it is put up before the Expert committee for grant of NOC.
  - 2) In the matter of M/s Aegis Ltd., Dimna Chowk, Jamshedpur, it was mentioned that the activity of the firm is Call Centre having D.G.Sets of 3 x 500 KVA and there is no NOC guideline for the same. The unit comes under Green category as per CPCB norms.
- **B**. Mr. Madhav Lakra, Director, MSME, Ranchi was invited during the Friday meeting at JSIA, to address the members & to apprise them on schemes on cluster development. He categorically mentioned that MSME Ministry, New Delhi has approved grant in Aid for development of any cluster formed on Govt. Industrial Area but not on any private Industrial Land/Area. He further clarified that as on date for formation of any cluster minimum 25 units (previously 20 unit), having the same line of manufacturing are required. The MSME Ministry has sanctioned Rs15 Crore for development of common facility centre under the cluster for which the Govt grant would be Rs13.5 Crore & remaining 1.5 crore would be the promoters share.

He emphasized on formation of Engineering Cluster, at Tupudana, as it has been principally approved by the GoJ and initiation from Promoter is needed to proceed further on DSR.

Mr Lakra also informed about cluster on Lean Manufacturing schemes & said that an Aid of Rs.5- lacs can be given for strengthening the Association under National Manufacturing Competitiveness Program (NMCP), for its up gradation, provided it could meet the criteria.

#### 10.02.14

Mr Anjay Pacheriwal attended IFC meeting in the chamber of Director Industries, at Nepal House at 11.00 A.M

Cases of five units were taken for hearing.

- 1. case no. 08/2011 & 14/2011 of M/s Eastern Engineering co, Tupudana: Both the cases were postponed for next date as petitioner could not pursue his case properly.
- 2. case no. 12/2011 & 03/2013 of M/s Alcast Engineering (P) Ltd, Bokaro: Both the cases were postponed for next date as petitioner was absent.
- 3. case no. 13/2012 of M/s VEXEL Computers (P) Ltd, Ranchi.: The case was discussed and shall be taken up for further examination due to objection raised by the respondent that the petitioner does not come under the purview of MSMED.

#### 11.02.14

**(A)**Hony Secretary & Mr. H.P.Biyani attended First Convocation ceremony of the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Batch of Diploma in Tool & Die Making & Advance Machinist Course of Jharkhand Govt MSME Tool Room, Tatisilwai. At 11.30 A.M.

Mr Champai Soren , Industries Minister, GoJ was the chief Guest while Mr Suhash Gokhle, VP , Jindal Steel & Power Ltd. & Mr. Niranjan Tirkey, Dy Director, Industries department were the Guest of Honour. Mr H.P.Biyani & Mr M.K.Gupta, Principal , JGTRTC also shared the Dias along with the dignitaries.

The trainees of 2007-11 & 2008-12 batches were given Diploma Certificates & few of them also were conferred with Gold Medal. Mr H.P. Biyani on behalf of his Firm M/s Raj Ceramics & on behalf of IRMA, Kolkata also sponsored Cash awards to four trainees. Mr Biyani also urged the Industries Minister that while his department has sanctioned a sum of Rs50 lacs for setting up a Common Testing Laboratory at JGTRTC, for the benefit of Mineral based Industries of the state, he should also request the MSME Ministry, New Delhi for grant of another Rs 5 crore so that Highly advanced Lab can be set up to cater the needs of the industries..

Mr Champai soren in his address congratulated the management of Tool Room for imparting value based education & developing skill of unemployed youths, which would provide them better opportunities in life.

Mr Suhash Gokhle was pleased to mention that many trainees from Tool Room have been engaged by JSPLtd. Pataratu.

**(B)** Mr Sharad Poddar, VP attended a meeting organized by FJCCI at Hotel BNR, Ranchi.

Mr Hemant Soren, CM, GoJ was the chief Guest. Mr Poddar requested the CM for earliest approval of the purchase Policy through Cabinet. The CM also instructed the Secretary Industries for action, but the Chief Secretary, GoJ ordered for its review, hence it has been stalled for the time being.

#### 13.02.14

Mr P.K.Dattani along with various representatives from Chamber, MP's, and Districts officers attended DRUCC meeting with the DRM, S.E.Rly, at the conference hall at Hatia.

Demands for new trains, increase in frequency of trains and other difficulties faced by commuters were brought to the notice of new DRM, Mr. Deepak Kashyap and his team. The DRM assured to take up the matters at various levels of Railways and would! try to sort out the problem at the earliest.

DRM also informed about a new train from Hatia to Yeswantpur being inaugurated on 15.02.2014 to run on weekly basis apart from the two already running. Thus there are now 3 trains from Hatia to Yeswantpur & vice versa in a week.

Mr Dattani also brought up the following matter :-

- 1). Approach Road to Hatia Station in bad condition and needs immediate attention, DRM assured to do his best.
- 2). RNC-HWH Exp. From Ranchi crawls after Santragachi and reaches Howrah normally 1 to 2 hrs late, though it runs in time till Santragachi. DRM informed that due to frequency of local trains this problems persists and he seemed helpless to do anything in the matter. However, he suggested to get down at Santragachi to reach Kolkata early or change to local trains at Santragachi. This problem was SMS by the president, Mr. Arun Khemka.

- 3). Another Problem faced by commuters travelling by 1<sup>st</sup> A.C. of RNC- HWH train regarding Attendant, Blanket, Coach, Maintenance were also brought to DRM's notice and he instructed the concerned person to look into the matter and report to him.
- 4). Rack Problem and demurrage problem faced by one of our member, brought to the notice of DRM . On enquiring from concerned person, it was informed that such problem can never happen as demurrage is charged after 12 hours of placing the racks at the site and not before that. DRM requested to cite any Specific problem faced by our members.

#### 16.02.14

One large delegation led by the President met Mr Vinay Kr. Chaubey,IAS, Dy. Comissioner, Ranchi to seek clarification on Land conversion norms for purchase of 75/100 acres of land for developing Industrial Area. It is but obvious that such a big plot of land will come under the purview of CNT Act, hence clarification was sought.

The DC was pleased to inform us that for Industrial Area, such land can be transferred, subject to fulfilling few formalities. He was categorical to mention that in case any complain of misuse of land viz for commercial purpose, is received from any land owner, the land will be returned to the owner and the amount paid to him will stand forfeited.

#### 19.02.14

Mr Sharad Poddar VP, attended the SLEPC meeting under chairmanship of the Chief Secretary at Project Building at 3.00 P.M.The proposal of IT Tower at Namkum, Silk Park at IRBA, Ranchi & Trade cum Incubation Centre at Deoghar were financially approved. Besides new proposal for Silk Park at Kharsawan, Common facilities at AIADA we also sanctioned. In the Silk Park at IRBA, project cost of 22.87 crore was approved and decided to be undertaken on PPP mode, inviting local entrepreneurs to invest and run the show. A sum of Rs.24.67 crore was also sanctioned for Trade cum Incubation centre at Deoghar.

Mr Poddar suggested that the state's Export Policy should be formed immediately and an Industrial Area near Ranchi, should be developed exceptionally for export oriented units through ASIDE funds , to which everyone agreed.

#### 20.2.14.

Mr Sharad Poddar, VP was invited as Chief Guest in FIEO's meeting on Identification of Exportable Goods, at Chamber Bhawan. The meeting discussed at length the details of Goods, available in Jharkhand, which can be exported. Mr Sharad Poddar assured the house that to promote exporting units, JSIA will give all possible support.

#### 21.02.14

A small delegation led by the President met Mr Dipankar Panda, IAS, Director of Industries, at his chamber at Nepal House and congratulated him on his new assignment.

President apprised him of few pending matters related to delay in issue of EM Pt-II, Development of new Industrial Park, in accordance with the clauses of Industrial Policy & Refund of ITC of Exporting units lying with the commercial tax department etc.

Mr Panda was very positive in his response and said that he needed some time to study clauses of the Industrial Policy to initiate suitable action for its implementation. He also requested JSIA to comply the list of units whose EM Pt- II are pending and assured to organize a meeting soon , with the concerned officers to resolve the same.

Mr D.K.Tiwari assured to look into the matter and also suggested to meet the newly appointed chairman of JSMDC Mr. Bidesh Singh, MLA, for relief.

## 27.09.13

Hony Secretary & Jt Secretary met Mr. Mast Ram Mina, Commissioner, Commercial Taxes at his chamber at Project Building at 10.30 A. M and apprised him of the issues related to commercial taxes and was requested for its redressal.

- 1. To withdraw the show cause notices, issued against many dealers for non registration of their Diesel Generators under the Act. Mr Meena assured to look into the matter and advise his department to refrain from any coercive action for non compliances of notices. JSIA suggested to consider registration from current date, which he agreed On the matter of refund of input tax under JVAT, he assured to initiate action soon.
- 2. The commissioner clarified the Pink Road Permit will become mandatory w.e.f.17.10.2013. Moreover he said that time limit specified for Blue Permit is sufficient, however any specific case of delay due to transshipment may be brought to the notice of the concerned circle thru email to the concerned circle for seeking relief.
- 3.He assured that Advisory committee will start functioning soon.

Later on above officer bearers attended a meeting with the Chief Secretary, GoJ, at the conference hall at Project Building at 11.15.A.M on pollution matter.

Besides, President of FJCCI, Ms Vandana Dhadel, Secretary Industries, Ms Himani Pandey, Director Industries, Mrs Alka Tiwari, Principal Secretary, Forest & Environment, Mr Sanjay Sinha, Member Secretary, JSPCB were also present in the meeting.

The CS was very focused on the issue and during deliberated with the MS, he directed him to initiate action on following points.:

- 1. To curb inordinate delay in issue of NOC/CTO the department would develop software for on line filing & tracking of applications within 15 days. After that no application would be accepted off line.
- 2. Issue of consent for NOC /CTO is to be granted within 120 days as per the provisions of Air & water Act., otherwise the consent will be deemed to be granted and the department will issue a letter on line to the applicant to that effect.
- 3. On imposition of many irrelevant condition in the NOC/CTO by the Board, the CS agreed to the contentions of JSIA & FJCCI and advised MS to sort it out jointly in a meeting with representatives of JSIA, FJCCI & Secretary Industries so that MSMEs are not harassed unduly by the Board officers for its compliances.
- 4. On implementation of RWH, it was agreed to follow the simple guidelines of Jharkhand Ground water Directorate and Board will not insist upon to follow Central Ground water Directorate.
- 5. On procurement of raw materials from valid source for Mineral based industries, the CS was categorical and said that no relief can be granted on that ground.
- 6. On obtaining license under MMDR Act, for the Mineral based units the CS heard the plea of JSIA and asked MS to clarify the matter, whether the Board has got any order setting aside the order of Hon'ble Jharkhand High Court .by the Apex Court.
- 7. On JSIA's representation as member in the Board, MS said that they are invited in the NOC Expert committee meeting regularly, as such their representation in the Board is not considered.
- 8. On non implementation of provisions of the notifications on grant of consent for the extended period for various categories of industries, CS suggested to approach Appellate authority" Member Board of Revenue Committee" comprising Secretary Industries & one more member, and seek redressal.
- 9. MS could not justify his claim that all currently issued NOC & CTO are uploaded on Board's web site, as he could not show it to the members present in the meeting. The CS again directed MS to update Board's web site and initiate on line process for applications.

# 17.10.13

President & Hony Secretary & Mr V.K.Mahendru, PP met Mr Chandrama Mishra, GM, JSMDC and requested him to consider release of coal allotment orders of units who had failed to furnish CTO from JSPCB. And they may be given some time by which they would submit the same.
