SECRETARY REPORT FROM 28.05.2022 to 22.07.2022.

01.06.2022: Jharkhand State Pollution Control Board (JSPCB) Organized one day State Level Workshop on "Carbon Budgeting and Neutrality: The Way-Forward for Industries" "Future-Ready Jharkhand, It was attended by President Sri Philip Mathew & Hony. Secretary Sri Ajay Kr. Dadheech.

The key objective of this workshop was to constructively deliberate the broader perspectives on current status of emissions, challenges in their quantification and reporting for carbon budgeting and neutrality, and further develop a suitable roadmap for achieving the net-zero scenario in Jharkhand. Therefore, a multilateral consensus on the accountability regime and development of a carbon budgeting and neutrality roadmap through discussions between the government agencies, industries, sustainability organizations and stakeholders from key economic sectors is important to implement the effective steps towards achieving this ambitious climate goal. President too was a speaker of the seminar.

07.06.2022: An appointment was granted by Secretary Industries, Project Bhawan, Dhurwa, Ranchi to apprise her on various issues of Industries. It was attended by President, Sri Philip Mathew, Vice President Sri Anjay Pacheriwala, Jt. Secretary Sri Vivek Bagla.

We brought the following issues to the notice of Industries Secretary:

- 1) Subsidy disbursed by Industry department is retained by banks and is released after three years from date of disbursement. Since the disbursement itself happens in 2-3 years from date of application, practically, MSMEs receive the amount after 5-6 years. We suggest a small change. Banks may be instructed to retain the subsidy for a period of three years from the Date of Production (DOP) OR Date of Disbursement whichever is earlier.
- 2) Effective monitoring of Single Window for timely disposal of applications, required under Clause 10. Of J.I.I.P.P. 2021 (Monitoring & Evaluation and Grievance Redressal) required. Due to non effective working and monitoring of Single Window, many industries are suffering. Timely renewal / grant of various permissions is key to running /starting an industry. The main **PAIN POINTS** are brought to the notice was as under:
 - a) As per provisions of the single window act all applications have to be routed through the single window, which would be monitored and delays to be made accountable. But practically it is not being followed.
 - b) Application for New Electricity connection is too complicated. Fresh look as a whole, especially "application process flow" is required. If needed some private consultant / best practice of another state may be engaged.
 - c) Pollution, matters / Factory License grant / renewal etc. applications too are not being disposed off through the single window.
 - d) Factory Licence not being issued within any timeline.
 - e) Licence being rejected on flimsy grounds.
 - f) Single Window for timely disposal of applications, required under Clause 10. (Monitoring & Evaluation and Grievance Redressal) required.
